## THE CHURCH

The current St Mary's was completed in 1848 to replace the old St Mary's, the tower of which stands in the churchyard. It is a busy parish church, with three services each Sunday as well as baptisms, weddings and funerals. The choir provides training from the age of 6 and the church hosts toddler groups, organ recitals, coffee mornings, Café Nescot, social trips and lots more.

### **Churchyard and Old Church Tower Tours - 12.00, 2.00**

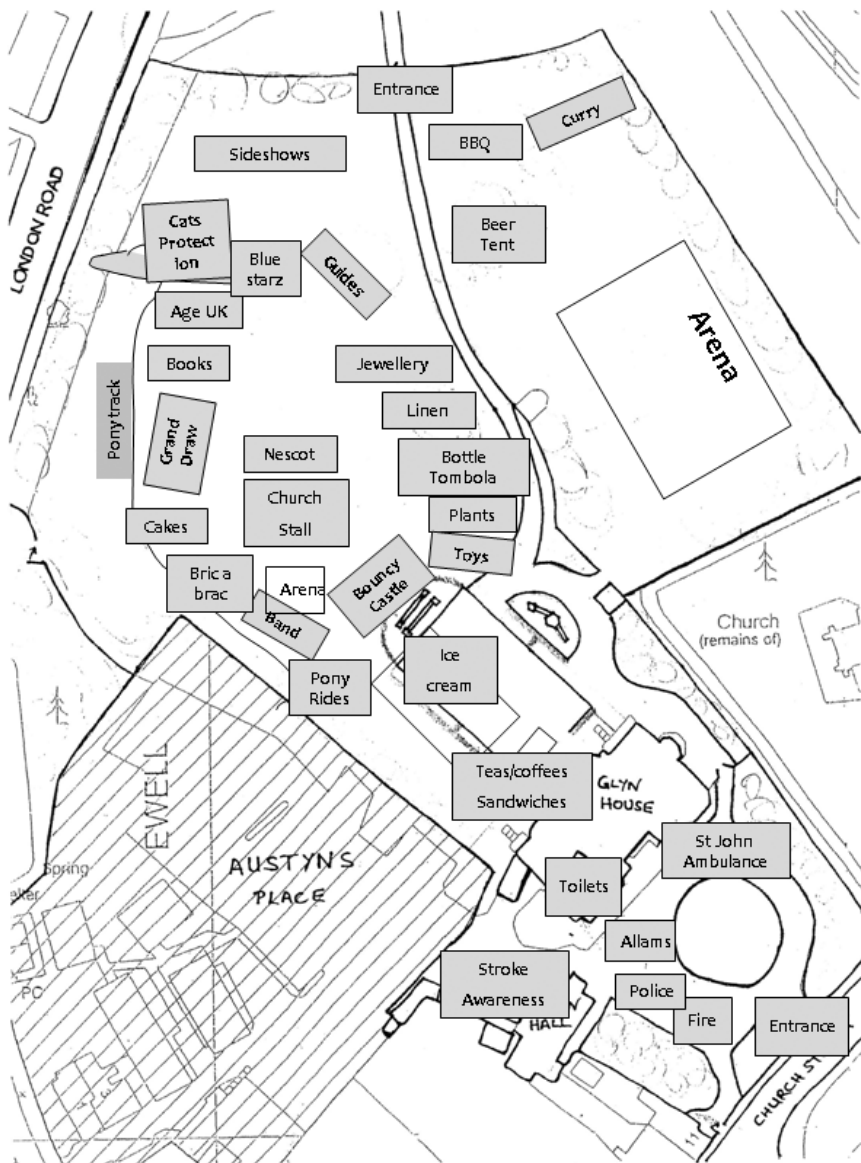
This tour will take a look at some of the more interesting gravestones in the churchyard and cover the history of the old church tower

## CHILDREN AT ST. MARY'S

Children are welcome at all our services. We aim to cater especially for them and their families through:

**Toddle Up!** A short monthly service (at 11-11.30am) aimed at the very young, full of action, play and song.

**'Children's Hour.'** Each Sunday during term-time the children learn about the Christian Faith in a happy and creative way. They join the congregation in church for the last part of the 0930 Sung Eucharist, at which they come to the altar for a blessing. For approximately ages 3-9.

**Wayfarers.** For ages approximately 9 and over. This starts and finishes in the Eucharist, but in between they receive teaching which can lead them on to their First Communion and eventually to Confirmation.

**Family Services** held on designated Sundays throughout the year at the 9.30am Eucharist and 11am Mattins

**A Crèche** is available during the Sung Eucharist on the first Sunday in the month and as and when parents feel the need for it.

**St Mary's Toddler Groups** are held on Monday, Thursday and Friday. These are occasions of fun with parent or carer.

**The Parish Choir** has a wide musical repertoire, and children from about the age of seven can join this mixed-age group. As well as experiencing the regular round of the Church's services throughout the year they are able to **benefit from a free musical training and education.**

**The Junior Singing Group** caters for 6 to 11-year olds and also offers a **free musical education** along with aural help for instrumentalists.

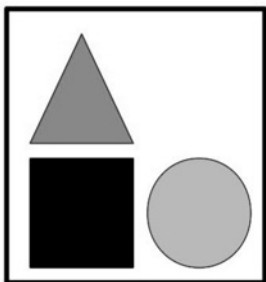

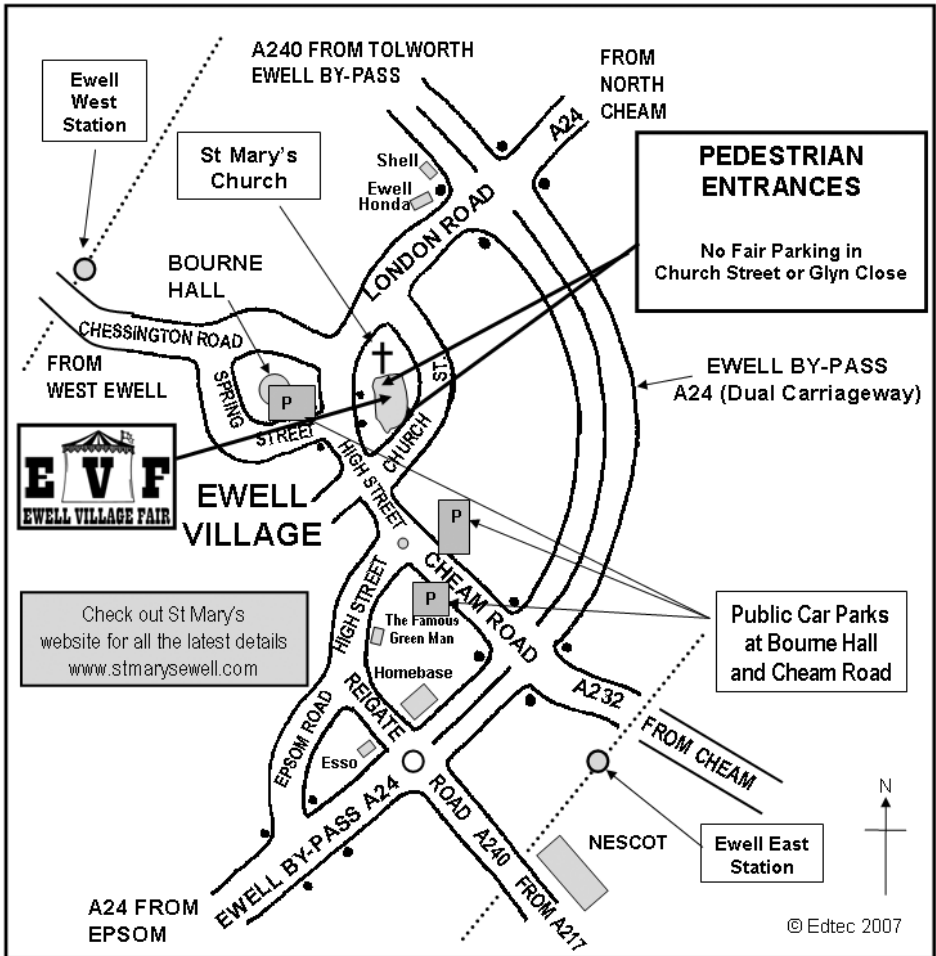
