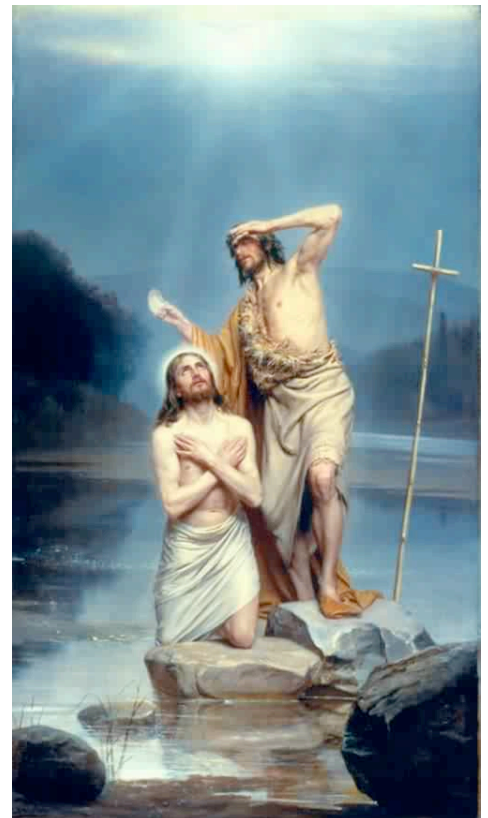

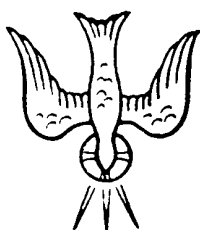
NOTICES
