The Parish Choir

We are continually recruiting singers from years 5 to 8, older students from year 9 to sixth form, plus undergraduates and recent graduates. Choristers and Choral and Organ scholars are paid, but we have adult volunteers too. Full training will be given, including singing lessons, theory lessons for beginners, progressing to grade 5 and beyond, preparation for music exam aural tests, sight reading, and sightsinging, workshops, performance opportunities, occasional tours, and the opportunity to learn a fantastic range of music. This free tuition is



worth £1,200 a year compared with private tuition (30 lessons per year @£40 per lesson)

Coaching will take place at St Mary's during term time after school, or on Saturday at a mutually convenient time.

Choir practice is on Friday. For children up to year 8 this runs from 7pm until 8.15pm. For older students and adults this runs from 7.30pm until 9.30pm. On Sundays the choir sings at the 9.30am service in term time and about once a month for Choral Mattins at 11.15am and Choral Evensong at 5.30pm.

We also offer Choral and Organ Scholarships.

The Willis Organ is magnificent, being one of the best in Surrey. Choral Scholarships



are for outstandingly promising singers who can take a lead in the choir and have the confidence to sing solos. Scholars receive an enhanced payment. They often go on to study music at a high level. Recent leavers have won Scholarships to Durham, Manchester, Oxford and Cambridge.
