The parish choir will sing Byrd's 4-part mass, and during Communion, Bogoroditsye Dyovo – Rachmaninov and Ave Maria – Guy.

Everyone is of course welcome to attend whether or not they intend to receive Holy Communion. For those receiving Holy Communion, it is in one kind only (under the form of bread) and there is no sharing of the Peace at present.

The church is cleaned between all uses, and hand sanitizer etc is available. Please observe social distancing, and note that it is now a legal requirement for face coverings to be worn unless you are exempt or while leading the service, e.g. reading.
